- o Individual participation € 27,50 (€ 30,- if you pay on the day itself on location)
- Equipe-team € 50,-
- Cancelling participation: fencers will be able to cancel free of any charge up to 48 hours before the start of the tournament (Thursday 19 December 09:00 am). In case a participant cancels later, there will be no refund.
- Fencing equipment and weapons: the equipment and clothing of the participants must be in accordance with the applicable requirements of the KNAS/FIE.
- > Material sales: Leon Paul Germany is present on Saturday and Sunday.
- Referees: when an fencing club is represented by 4 or more fencers the club must provide one or more certified referee(s).

Certified: in the Netherlands at least level 3, abroad at least national level.

If a club cannot bring the right amount of referees, a fine of € 50,- per missing referee will follow.
