Duels' schedule

Saturday September 28th 2024:

Team tournament formula: 1 round in pools, followed by a direct elimination. From T-16. all places will be fenced.

Youngsters' tournament: six separate competitions for sabre fencers (mixed boys and girls) (U 20) born in 2005, 2006, 2007, for sabre fencers (mixed boys and girls) (U 17) born in 2008, 2009 for sabre fencers (mixed boys and girls) (U 15) born in 2010, 2011, for sabre fencers (mixed boys and girls) (U 13) born in 2012, 2013, for sabre fencers (mixed boys and girls) (U 11) born in 2014, 2015 and for sabre fencers (mixed boys and girls) (U 9) born in 2016, 2017.

The competition "U20" is open for fencers born in 2008 or 2009 as well. The competition "U17" is open for fencers born in 2010 or 2011 as well The competition "U15" is open for fencers born in 2012 or 2013 as well. The schedule allows participating in both competitions.

Youngsters' tournament formula: depending of the number of participants. Youngsters (U9), (U11), (U 13), (U 15), (U17) and (U20) can all fence with a blade Nr. 5. Participants will have to submit a national membership card 2024-2025 (for Belgian and foreign fencers) Entry fee: 40 Euro for team and 20 Euro per person for youngsters' tournament

Money prizes team competition: 250 Euro for the first team, 125 for the runner-up

Money Prizes (both Men and Women):

More than 50 participants: 500,00 Euro first place, 250,00 Euro second place, 100,00 Euro third place. Less than 50 participants: 300,00 Euro first place, 150,00 Euro second place, 75,00 Euro third place. Prizes will be awarded for boys and girls separately.

> FIE Sunday's Men's Sabre and Women's Sabre competitions are qualified as a satellite tournament on the official F.I.E. calendar. Participants need an international F.I.E. license for the 2024-2025 season. Fencers have to apply for this license at their national fencing federation. The 8 finalists will receive world cup points.

Formula According to F.I.E. regulations: 1 round in pools followed by direct elimination without "repêchage".

Entrance fee 35,00 Euro (Men), 35,00 Euro (Women) will be collected on tournament's day

Equipment Participant's equipment according to F.I.E. regulations. Maraging saber obligatory. Weapon control for the Men's and Women's sabre competition (vest, mask, weapons, manchette, glove) before competition start (from 8.15 to 9.30 am). An equipment stand will be present at the venue. Participants qualified for the 32-tableau must have their name on the back of their electric vest, as well as the national colours on their fencing pants.

By car:

- From Brussels: take the A12 to Antwerp. Take exit 7 N16 "Sint-Niklaas-Puurs". Continue on N16 till crossing with E17. Take E17 direction "Gent". Take exit 11 (Lochristi). Follow signs to "Puyenbroek"
- From Oostende: take the E40 direction Gent. At crossing with E17 follow direction E17 "Antwerpen". Take exit 11 (Lochristi). Follow signs to "Puyenbroek"
- From Lille/Kortrijk or from Antwerpen/Holland: take the E17 exit 11 (Lochristi). Follow signs to "Puyenbroek"
