Rules of Participation:

Entry

Fencers must be entered via Ophardt . Closing Date for Entries 28.04.2017.

- No late entries will be accepted. Please ensure that you have entered by due date.
- Fencers must have a 2017 GFA licence. (See below)
- The age groups below apply for entry in the competition.
- Fencers must be aware of doping regulations. Any fencer may be tested.

Competition Rules:

- 1. Plastrons are compulsory, and breastplates for females & ball boxes for males are recommended.
- 2. Only breeches and long socks, no tracksuit pants may be worn.
- 3. Weapons, body wires, masks, gloves and electric jackets must be presented at the weapons check.
 - Weapons and body wires will again be checked on the piste.
 - Electric Jackets and mask bibs will be tested for resistance (not just for closed circuit).
 - Foil masks must have electric bibs.
- 4. Any fencer on the piste must have 2 working weapons and 2 working body wires alongside them.
- 5. Size 3 Blades are required for U11's & U13's Foil & Epee.
- 6. A Fencer may only enter his/her own age group, plus one up. Fencers who are ranked in the top three of his/her age group, may forgo his/her age group and fence in the next age group and one up from that.
- 7. A Fencer may enter a maximum of two age groups per weapon.
- 8. The Competition will not be delayed by waiting for Fencers. Fencers must sign the attendance register before the start of the competition. If a Fencer is not present at Roll Call (30 minutes before the scheduled starting time) he/she will be excluded.
- 9. To stage a single gender event, at least 4 fencers are required to make up an event.
- 10. A **mixed gender** event will only be staged if there are not a minimum of 4 male fencer **AND** 4 female fencers registered for the relevant event. (e.g. if there are say 2 female and 5 male



fencers, or 3 female fencers and 3 male fencers, we will only stage a mixed event.

- 11. If separate male and female events are staged, <u>NO</u> female may enter a male event.
- 12. Pools
 - If there are 5 or less fencers in the event, a pool & a Final only will be fenced. In the event of equal first placings based on number of <u>Victories</u>, indices will be ignored and final placings established by "barrage". Gold and Silver medals only will be awarded.
 - If there are 6-7 entries, only 4 fencers will be promoted to a DE of 4. Third place to be determined by match for third place. Gold, Silver and one Bronze medal only to be awarded.
 - If there are more than 8 entries, multiple pools and normal DE rounds will be fenced. Maximum pool size = 7, minimum = 4. Gold, Silver and 2 Bronze medals to be awarded.
- 13. The progress of the schedule depends on the availability of pistes and referees.
- 14. All participants need to be registered 2017 GFA Members, (All-R350) and must sign and hand in the indemnity form as well as the Attendance Register (different from Sign in Sheet).

The Events:

- 1 Round of Pools, 5 points in Pools, 15 in DE.
 - Senior Men's and Women's Epee, Foil & Sabre.
 - Junior (u20) Men's and Women's Epee, Foil & Sabre.
 - Cadet (u17) Men's and Women's Epee & Foil.
 - Minim (u15) Men's and Women's Epee & Foil.
 - Benjamin (u13) Men's and Women's Epee & Foil.
- 1 Round of Pools, 4 points in Pools, 10 in DE.
 - Pupi (u11) Epee & Foil

Medal Ceremonies

Will take place as soon after the completion of an event as possible, bearing in mind that other bouts continue and may not be interrupted unless agreed to by the referees.

• The Medals:

- Gold, Silver & 2 Bronze, where there are 2 Pools (8 Fencers or more.)
- Gold, Silver & 1 Bronze, where there is 1 pool (4 7 Fencers)
- A Veteran's Gold Medal in Senior Events Foil, Epee & Sabre.





Note from the Competition Organiser/s:

- Please be aware that due to the nature of the Arnold Classic we are limited to 4 Pistes,
- Entries: Please do your utmost to enter before the closing date in the correct (weapon & age group) you want to participate in. Should you withdraw once signed-in please advise the DT immediately, cross out your name and sign.
- Fencers are requested to assist in the efficient running of the competition by signing in for each event they have entered prior to Roll Call, and be prepared/waiting at the Piste, 10 minutes prior to their pools start time.
- Please remember that warming up or training without wearing regulation fencing clothing or equipment that conforms to the clothing regulations is an offence which carries a First time yellow card, second time Black Card. (ref: Art t.15.2).
- Please remember to walk back to the reel box and release the clip slowly so as not to damage the spool in the reel. A fencer who releases a clip incorrectly will be handed a yellow card by the Referee and fined R50 by the Organising Committee.

To Enter:

2017 <u>Registration and Indemnity forms</u> must be completed. (See separate email for forms) and a GFA 2017 Licence obtained by the Fencer prior to entry into this event. The annual fee is R350 per Member and is payable in January of each year. This must be obtained from and paid to the GFA. Proof of Payment to be submitted with entry.
