Rules of the competition

- Correct attire is required. (Fencing breeches and long socks, no tracksuit pants may be worn).
- Plastrons, Breast plates for girls & ball box for boys are STRONGLY recommended.
- On arrival at the event please sign-in on the Roll-call sheet. The sign-in sheet will be removed from the Sign-in Desk 30 minutes before the start of an events scheduled start time on the programme. If you are not signed-in at that time you WILL be scratched from the event.
- The Fencer is expected to be dressed and ready and present him/herself on the piste 10 minutes before the scheduled start of the event.
- At least 4 fencers are required to make up an event.
- All Events are **mixed** gender events.
- Weapons, body wires, masks and electric jackets must be presented at the weapon's check. Weapons check is open from 1 hour prior to start to Roll Call of the last scheduled event.
- The competition will not be delayed waiting for fencers.
- You may only enter two age groups per weapon.
- U 13 & U11 must use No. 3 size blades for epee.
- U11's fence <u>4 hits per bout</u> in the pools & 10 hits in <u>DE</u> (direct elimination) which last 6 minutes (<u>3 periods of 2 minutes each</u>) with 2 x 1 minute rest intervals, 3 periods of 2 minutes, 1 minute rest between period.

Medals:

For each age group a Gold Medal for first place, a Silver Medal for second place and Bronze medal for third place will be awarded.

Where there are two pools or more, two bronze medals will be awarded.

At the end of the Season, there will we an award for the Top Ranked Individual by Age group and Top Ranked School - 1st, 2nd & 3rd Place by number of medals won.

If someone needs something fixed for the competition, such as weapons or body wires, please contact Thulani or Vincent.

You may enter via your Club Administrator via Ophardt. Entries must be done by COB WEDNESDAY 14th September 2017.
