- 9) **Publicity**: The FIE Publicity Code will be strictly enforced.
- **10) FIE Rules**: The Competition will run in accordance with the FIE Rules for Competitions. The Directoire Technique will, however, reserve the right to decide, without right of appeal, on any issues not covered by the FIE Rules or by these Rules.
- 11) Referees: Each country is required to send FIE qualified referees in accordance with FIE rule o.81. Official candidates for FIE refereeing exams may also referee provided they hold a <u>current</u> FIE Fencer's licence (Rule t.35). The names of referees, together with their FIE Category, must be emailed to British Fencing (<u>headoffice@britishfencing.com</u>) 7 days before the event. (With 5-9 fencers 1 referee must be sent, 10 or more fencers requires 2 referees to be sent.)
