

## U23 European Circuit Competition in Men's and Women's epée 30 September – 01 October, 2017.

It is with great pleasure that I invite you to the U23 competition on behalf of the Hungarian Fencing Federation, which will be held in Budapest, Hungary on the 30<sup>th</sup> of September, 2017. A team competition will be held on Sunday, 1<sup>st</sup> of October, 2017, which is open to all federations.

Details of the competition are as follows:

Dates: 30. 09. 2017 (Saturday):

- 10.00 Men's Epée individual (EFC U23)
- 14.00 Women's Epée individual (EFC U23)

01. 10. 2017 (Sunday):

- 09.00 Men's Epée team
- 13.00 Women's Epée team

Venue: Gerevich Aladár National Sports Hall (1146 Budapest Istvánmezei út 3-5.)

Participants: fencers from Hungary according to HFF rules and foreign fencers

Entries: all fencers must be entered through EFC web site to the individual events by their national fencing federations. Fencers aged under 23 should be in possession of a valid EFC license for the 2017/2018 season. Fencers aged over 23 must only be registered at the EFC.

Team entries should be sent to <a href="mailto:hunfencing@hunfencing.hu">hunfencing@hunfencing.hu</a> (with team name and names of fencers). There is no limitation on number of teams that can be entered.

Presence confirmation: no later than 30 minutes before indicated start of competition

Entry fee: individual 2.500, - HUF / 10 EUR team: 8000, - HUF / 30 EUR

Formula: according to FIE JWC rules. However, the DT of the tournament is entitled to adopt modifications on the spot.

Equipment: FIE 800N underplastron is required

Results ceremony: the finalists will receive prizes. The organizer will provide medical service.
