COMPETITION RULES:

 ENTRY: A Fencer will only be permitted to enter his/her own age group, and ONE up.
 Except where there is no event offered in the Age Group of the Fencer e.g.

Cadet Sabre.

- 2. Fencers must sign-in for each competition at the Registration Table.
- 3. Fencers are to sign the provided Attendance Register & Indemnity Forms with registration, at the Registration Table.
- 4. The Organising Committee reserves the right to change the order of the programme. Finishing times can only be estimated once all entries have been received. Such times are dependent on the number of entries, availability of Referees and the promptness of Fencers to present themselves on the Piste.
- AGE GROUPS: Season 2017/2018
 Minimum age: No fencer under the age of 12 years as on the 31st December 2017 may enter in the official Ophardt categories.

Cadet (u17)

Under 17 years of age at midnight December 31, 2017. (2001, 2002, 2003)

Junior (u20)

Under 20 years of age at midnight December 31, 2017. (1998, 1999, 2000)

- 6. Only the top 4 Nationally ranked Cadet fencers may enter the Senior Event. These fencers will however not be allowed to fence Cadets if they choose to fence Senior.
- 7. A competition will only take place if there is a minimum of four (4) entries by the closing date.
- 8. No fencer will be allowed to fence without a 2018 FFSA license.
- 9. The competition will not be delayed by waiting for fencers fencers must signin by the Roll Call time before the competition, and if a fencer is not at Roll Call they will be excluded.
- 10. Fencers must present themselves at the piste 10 minutes before the announced starting time of an event. Any fencer not present at the piste and ready to fence (may not still be fencing in another event at that time), will be scratched from the event.
 Fencers are therefore cautioned against entering events that are likely to partially overlap. This particularly applies to fencers entering more than one weapon in more than one age group.





- 11. The progress of the schedule depends on the availability of pistes & referees.
- 12. FFSA Competition regulations will apply and are to be adhered to.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT

- 1. Weapons, Masks, Electric Jackets, Body Wires, Mask Clips , Sabre Manchettes & Gloves are to be submitted to weapons check before the event, and will be checked again by the officiating referees before pool and DE bouts.
- 2. 350N Plastrons must be worn.
- 3. No tracksuit pants may be worn. Breeches and long socks only.
- 4. All fencers on the piste must have access to at least one spare working weapon, body wire and mask clip at the side of the piste.
- 5. Electric jackets, mask bibs, sabre gloves & manchettes will be tested for dead spots.

GENERAL

1. Provinces must confirm the names of their **accompanying Referees** to Mike Stafford, (Head of the Referee Commission) via email, and the organizers by the 28 February 2018 (closing date). Referees sent by their province may not refuse if called upon to referee.

2. **Referees**:

Provinces are reminded of their **obligation to make Referees** available - and to enter them on Ophardt by the closing date according to the table below (source FFSA Minutes July 2017) :

- 1 10 fencers = Nil Referee 11 - 20 fencers = 1 Referees
- 21 30 fencers = 2 Referees
- 31 40 Fencers = 3 Referees
- 40 plus = 4 Referees

This should not be confused with the **hosting Province** supplying referees, over and above its obligation, to run an efficient competition. It this instance, a referee from a different province may be requested to assist at the event, where his/her travel expenses will be paid by the L.O.C.

Where a **Visiting Province** wishes to employ a local resident referee to meet their Provinces Referee obligation, a request for that referee must be made to the L.O.C. In this instance, the requesting province will pay the equivalent of R600 per day for the services of that referee to the LOC.





- 3. Fencers must be aware of **doping regulations**. Any fencer may be tested.
- 4. If anyone needs **repairs** done to their weapons, or body wires, please contact Thulani. Please note repairs done at the Competition are at a cost and payable to the person/s doing the repair.
- 5. Medals
 - Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals will be awarded for each Event, and a Gold Medal for top placed Veteran in the Senior Events.
 - If an Event has less than 6 entries only Gold and Silver medals will be awarded.
 - All Fencers receiving medals are required to be dressed accordingly in Fencing attire (Jacket zipped closed) or their Club / Provincial / National official track suit. No t-shirts or branded attire will be permitted.
 - Medals will be presented shortly after the end of an event, but bearing in mind that other bouts are to continue and may not be interrupted unless agreed to by the Referees.

- 7. Spectators, Fencers & Coaches are reminded to refresh their understanding of rules t82, t83 & t92 & t93 with regard to behavior.



DIRECTIONS: to Mokopane College

- From OR Tambo / Pretoria

- R21 North to Pretoria
 - Off ramp to left (N1 to Polokwane)
- N1 Northerly direction
- 3 * Toll Gates (Phumalani Plaza; Carusel Plaza; Kranskop Plaza) (All are E-Tag compatible, budget R 150 one way)
- 4th Toll Gate "Nyl Plaza"
 Left hand lane off rampto Mokopane.
- Off Ramp T-Junction O Left to Mokopane
- 2nd T-Junction
 - o Right to Mokopane
- Into Mokopane
 - First Robot
 - Left (into Geyser Street)
 - Second robot
 - Right (into Dudu Madisha Street)
 - Across 4 robots
 - One block before the 5th Robot
 - Right (into Rufus Seakamela Steet)
 - "Mokopane College
 - Will be on the right
 - Through security gate down to Parking Area.

The Fencing Hall is on the right as one walks through the main entrance structure.

 - 2nd Robot
 - Right (into Nelson Mandela Drive)
 - 5th Robot
 - Right (into Dudu Madisha Street)
 - Across 1 robot
 - One block before the 2nd Robot
 - Right (into Rufus Seakamela Steet)
 - "Mokopane College
 - Will be on the right
 - Through security gate down to Parking Area.
